JavaScript for Designer (AEM Forms Designer & LiveCycle Designer)

Description

AEM Forms Workbench is a 2 or 3 day, instructor-led course that can be taught in-person or virtually over Adobe Connect. You will learn to use AEM Workbench to design and develop AEM Forms JEE applications. If you wish to develop sophisticated AEM Forms applications with custom components, the additional third day option is required.

Each section begins with an activity to introduce you to the topic. Our Adobe-Certified Instructor will then teach the topic with a combination of lectures and demonstrations. Each topic will be enforced with an exercise where you can put into practice the functionality covered in the lesson. The exercise will build on each other so you will have a complete AEM Forms Workbench application when you are done.
