## Create Sites

**Course description:** This course covers the fundamentals and best practices of creating AEM Sites. Although there are many ways to create a website, this course will teach you the Adobe-recommended tools and techniques for creating a website in Adobe Experience Manager 6.5 and above. You will learn how to create custom templates and control their usage with custom policies.

You will learn how to create Proxy components for the core components and add them to AEM Policies on your templates. You will also learn how to customize these components with CSS and JavaScript to match your company's web standards. You will design a responsive layout for your form with Layout Mode and CSS, and learn how to target specific devices with the AEM emulator and with CSS media queries.

**Prerequisites:** None, although AEM and CRXDE experience is a plus

- Create an AEM Sites application
- Create Proxy components that reference the AEM Core Components
- Add the components to an AEM Sites template

- Configure different types of AEM Policies
- Create and manage Client Libraries
- Create AEM Sites pages and work with Layout mode
- Work with image assets from AEM Assets
- Understand the fundamentals of CSS (Cascading Style Sheets)
